Public Works Update – Pavement Maintenance August 15, 2019

2019 Pavement Maintenance Program

The City's 2019 Pavement Maintenance Program continues.

Chip Seal

Jackson County Roads completed the modified chip seal on Monday, August 12, 2019. The project extends on Crystal Drive from Highway 62 to Ashwood/Raywood Court.



Crack Seal/Seal Coat

C. R. Contracting completed crack sealing August 7, 2019. The Seal Coat project was completed Friday August 9, 2019.

Although not part of Eagle Point's program, Jackson County Roads paved Reese Creek Road Monday August 5, 2019. The driveways along Reese Creek Road were completed this last week by Knife River.



MicroCoat

The City is pursuing a pilot project using the MicroCoat technology. The MicroCoat provides additional treatment to the pavement beyond the typical seal coat. Eagle Point Drive and Silverado Way are the two selected test locations. The project is scheduled for mid-September.

Paving

Half street paving is planned for S. Buchanan Avenue and the intersection of Loto/Linn/Buchanan later this fall. The paving will be completed in conjunction with an ADA upgrade project at the intersection. Rogue Valley Sewer Services (RVSS) has a project proposed for Onyx Street. The City is planning to partner with RVSS to complete the paving on Onyx Street from Tabor Avenue to N. Shasta Avenue.
